Newport, RI to Lizard Point, UK

Amendment #1 to the SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

CHANGE SI 11 as follows:

11 THE FINISH

- 11.1 The finishing line is a line drawn south true from Lizard Point Lighthouse (49° 57.6' N; 005° 12.1' W). A yacht shall cross the finishing line within 4 NM of Lizard Point Lighthouse.
- 11.2 Yachts shall contact the finishing Committee on VHF Channel 72 when they are approximately 5 NM from the finishing line.
- 11.32 The Race Committee will record each yacht's finishing time (GMT/UT) and may useusing the time(s) from the tracking units and/or AIS to supplement the finishing information. If finishing at night, a yacht shall shine a bright light on her sails when approaching and crossing the finishing line. Shortly after a yacht has finished, the race committee will report their time to may contact them on VHF Channel 72 or via Sat phone.
- 11.43 As a backup, yYachts shall record their own finishing time (GMT/UT) as they cross the finishing line from west to east and enter that time on the onlineir Certificate of Compliance or written copy provided at registration. It is requested that yachts report their finishing time to the RYS Race Headquarters shortly after finishing via phone or email. Contact information is given in SI 21.

ADD SI 14.5 as follows:

14.5 Breaches of SIs 6.4, 6.5, 10.5 and IRPCAS Rule 10, Traffic Separation Schemes (TSS), will not be grounds for a protest by a yacht. This changes rule 60.1(a). However, a yacht that is cited by a government authority for a breach of IRPCAS Rule 10, may be protested by the Race Committee. This change rule 60.2.
