POINT CHARLIE

Point Charlie becomes an area that must be avoided, a polygon that covers an area defined as follows:

NW corner = $42^{\circ} 35' \text{ N} / 68^{\circ} 00' \text{ W}$

NE corner = $42^{\circ} 35' \text{ N} / 67^{\circ} 35' \text{ W}$

SW corner = $42^{\circ} 10^{\circ} \text{ N} / 67^{\circ} 50 \text{ W}$

SE corner = $42^{\circ} 10^{\circ} \text{ N} / 67^{\circ} 40 \text{ W}$

In addition, we are issuing a general advisory for the area between longitudes 67° W and 69° W. When you are sailing through this area, there is potential for an aggregation of Right Whales to the north of the 50 fathom contour of Georges Bank.
