## **AMENDMENT #1 to the SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

**CHANGE** "yachts" to "a yacht" in the second sentence of SI 11.3, so that the instruction now reads:

11.3 The Race Committee will record each yacht's finishing time (GMT/UT) and may use the times from the tracking units to supplement the finishing information. If finishing at night, a yacht may be asked to shine a bright light on her sails when approaching and crossing the finishing line. Shortly after a yacht has finished, the race committee will report their time to them on VHF Channel 72.

## **ADD** SI 15.3 and 15.4

- 15.3 A yacht that intentionally disables her transponder by any means shall be subject to protest by the Committee, which may result in penalties or disqualification.
- 15.4 In addition to the requirement in NOR 7.5 to have a satellite telephone turned on at all times while racing, it is recommended that yachts monitor email during the race. Each yacht shall provide their preferred email address(es) to the OA prior to the start.
